

Until effective regional flood mitigation is constructed in advance of urban development, such flooding will continue to escalate and spread into previously unflooded areas at higher elevations with increasing damage to property and danger to the residents; and


WHEREAS, such storm water flooding disrupts on-going business, school, medical, law enforcement, fire protection and other community activities; causes significant damage to property; risk to the safety and welfare of the watershed's residents; and thereby reduces the quality of life and adversely affects the economic vitality of our community neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the purposes for which the Cypress Creek Flood Control Coalition, a non-profit, 501C3 organization was organized and is set forth in their articles of incorporation to be "protecting and preserving human lives, properties, business, institutions and natural resources in and near the Cypress Creek watershed of Harris County, Texas" does coincide with the Association's desire to reduce endangerment conditions created by such storm water flooding;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors officially declares its support for the Cypress Creek Flood Control Coalition to promote and accomplish the purposes heretofore cited for the common good of the watershed community.
